Appearance in the table does not imply that the brand is no longer used or does not trade. Where a retailer has suffered several failures the date used is normally the one where most assets or staff were involved. We do not track in detail what has happened to these companies so please do not ask.
Retailers that have shrunk their businesses without going through administration are not included.
